

Gear Heads of Whatcom County Bylaws

Purpose of Club:

Attend garage/shop tours, car shows, and other activities with fellow club members and their guests with mutual interest in the enjoyment of classic vehicles.

Membership:

Initiation dues are \$25.00

After the first year, annual dues are \$20.00. This may be adjusted as required and approved by the board.

Members vehicles if on the public roads must be legally registered, fully insured and in good running condition.

Driving members must be legally licensed.

The club shall be non-commercial, non-sectarian and nonpartisan.

The name of the Club or name of any Board Member shall not be used in their official capacity as a Gear Head Director to endorse or promote a commercial concern or partisan interest.

Based on these fundamental beliefs, the board will remove any member from our club that does not hold to these standards in and around any Club activities, garage/shop tours, and car shows.

We will strive to enhance safety in the operation of all vehicles.

Club Officers:

Nominations to fill Board of Director vacancies will come from existing Board members. Election to the Board will be voted upon by existing Board members.

Meetings:

Board meetings will be held on the first Wednesday of each month, holidays excepted. The meeting place for each successive meeting will be determined at the previous meeting. Meetings may be held at members homes, restaurants, or other places deemed feasible. All Gear Heads are welcome.

Special meetings may be called by the Board of Directors or by request of five members. A quorum shall be met with 51% of Board of Directors in attendance.

The Board shall consist of 11 members in good standing. A quorum must be present to conduct club business.
